

Morning Liturgy

Instructions: This to be a communal morning liturgy that is based off the Lord's Prayer, the morning offices, and historic liturgies. This liturgy is to be conducted with the community with which you live with (family, spouse, roommate, etc), with a designated leader who will lead the liturgy. This liturgy is to be conducted before one has their morning drink or breakfast depending on the habits of the group.

Prayer of Orientation

Leader: Dear Heavenly Father,
Lord, we ask that you prepare our hearts to worship you with this liturgy,
We know that our hearts are prone to wander and that the heart is deceitful above all things.
Grant us by your spirit the power to prepare our hearts to live for your glory today.
Help us as we pray to glorify you and form our hearts into our union with Christ.

Prayer of Praise

All: Lord we praise you for your glory, goodness, holiness, justice, grace, and love.
You have given us a bed to sleep on, another day to live, air to breath, water to drink, food to eat, a people to be of, and a savior to worship.
We praise you for the glory and mystery of who you are three persons; Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, yet one God of one essence.
We praise you for the incarnation, life, atonement, resurrection and ascension of Christ. Who is of one essence yet fully God and fully Man.
Lord we praise you for who you are, what you have done, what you are doing, and what you will do.

Doxology

(Leader will begin song)

Prayer of Confession

(Please kneel or lift up hands for confession)

All: Lord we confess that we have sinned against you in thought, word, and deed.
Forgives us our sins and grant through your spirit the grace to forgive those who have sinned against us.

(Moment of silence for personal confession of sin)

Prayer of Assurance

Leader: The Lord has said in his word,
“If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.” (1 John 1:9)
All: Lord we thank you for your mercy.

Prayer of Supplication

(Individuals will pray and will end each prayer with “Lord in your Mercy” with all replying “bear our prayer”)

Individual: ...Lord in your mercy

All : Hear our Prayer

(The Last Prayer will be by the Leader)

Leader: ...Lord in your mercy

All : Hear our Prayer

Benediction

Leader: May the Lord bless you and equip you to be the light of the world and the salt of the earth.
Go into the world Saints, to fill and subdue the earth for the glory of our Lord
We pray this all in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
All: Amen

(Drink from your morning drink in this moment and meditate in silence on the liturgy)
